What is BLUEfasma about?

BLUEfasma is about rethinking circularity. In particular, BLUEfasma aspires to trigger change in the fishing/aquaculture sector of Mediterranean islands and coastal areas by reinforcing the adaptation of Circular Economy (CE) practices. BLUEfasma tackles the challenges of continual depletion of natural resources and the low Mediterranean CE innovation performance in fishing/aquaculture by empowering innovation capacity of SMEs, maritime clusters/networks and Public Authorities to boost blue CE growth. BLUEfasma project was launched in November 2019 and ends in June 2022.



The BLUEfasma partnership counts 14 partners from 9 Mediterranean countries: Greece,

Italy, France, Spain, Portugal, Cyprus, Malta, Croatia and Montenegro. Building on its diversity, the BLUEfasma team will foster synergies among key actors representing the quadruple innovation helix, driving the growth of the Blue Circular Economy in the fishing/aquaculture sector. The tool aims to tackle the lack of data on the circularity level of Mediterranean SMEs/enterprises related to fishing/aquaculture and their willingness to invest in blue Circular Economy. This user-friendly tool will be tested among key actors of the fishing/aquaculture sector in 11 Mediterranean territories, offering a review of current business practices and generating corresponding guidelines/ recommendation towards a more Circular Economy.

The BLUEfasma e-platform

The <u>BLUEfasma e-platform</u> is now online! The platform is designed to host the BLUEfasma

The tools include: the Circular Economy Knowledge Base, systematizing best practices, tools, solutions and methods in the sector of fishing/aquaculture; the BLUEfasma e-network, established to facilitate experience exchange and networking among actors of the fishing/aquaculture sector; MED Circular Economy Data, providing data related to the business readiness and willingness to invest in CE in the Mediterranean area; the BLUEfasma Circularity Self-Assessment Tool, used as a unified Mediterranean measure of SMEs/enterprises readiness and willingness to invest in CE and acting as a decision support tool; and the BLUEfasma Capacity Building Instrument, integrating financing/mentoring/coaching opportunities for R&I business investment in fishing/aquaculture.
